With the recent federal decision concerning Globalive and the testimony from the CRTC Chairman, Konrad von Finckenstein, it's clear that public policy related to the telecommunications sector is a 'hot' topic in Ottawa. The House of Commons Standing Committee on Industry has announced today that it is reviewing foreign ownership rules in the telecommunications sector. This may be the first chapter in a broad review of foreign ownership limits in a number of key sectors. The deadline for written submissions to the Industry Committee is April 29, 2010.
